2	relating to the authority of certain counties to designate a county
3	water recreation safety zone along certain rivers; authorizing a
4	fee.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 10, Local Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Chapter 328 to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 328. COUNTY WATER RECREATION SAFETY ZONE ALONG CERTAIN
9	RIVERS
10	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
11	Sec. 328.001. APPLICABILITY. This chapter applies only to
12	a county that borders or includes all or part of a river with
13	headwaters located on the campus of an institution of the Texas
14	State University System.
15	Sec. 328.002. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
16	(1) "Fee" means a county water recreation safety zone
17	fee authorized by Subchapter C.
18	(2) "Fund" means a county water recreation safety zone

recreational equipment intended for use on a river or other body of

water, including a canoe, tube, raft, boat, or kayak.

(3) "Water-oriented recreational equipment" means

(4) "Zone" means a county water recreation safety zone

- 1 SUBCHAPTER B. DESIGNATION OF COUNTY WATER RECREATION SAFETY ZONE
- 2 Sec. 328.021. AUTHORITY TO DESIGNATE ZONE. (a) The
- 3 commissioners court of a county may designate a contiguous
- 4 geographic area located in the county that is adjacent to and
- 5 includes all or part of a river described by Section 328.001 as a
- 6 county water recreation safety zone.
- 7 (b) The commissioners court of a county may not designate a
- 8 zone under this subchapter unless the commissioners court first
- 9 complies with the requirements of Sections 328.023, 328.024,
- 10 328.025, and 328.026.
- 11 Sec. 328.022. PURPOSE OF ZONE. A county may designate a
- 12 zone only for the purpose of improving the public health, safety,
- 13 and welfare of:
- 14 (1) residents of the zone; and
- 15 (2) individuals who engage in recreational activities
- 16 in, on, or along a river described by Section 328.001 that is
- 17 <u>located in the zone.</u>
- 18 Sec. 328.023. PROPOSAL TO DESIGNATE ZONE. (a) The
- 19 commissioners court of a county:
- 20 $\underline{\text{(1)}}$ may propose the designation of a zone on the
- 21 commissioners court's own motion; and
- 22 (2) shall propose the designation of a zone if the
- 23 county clerk receives a written petition for the designation signed
- 24 by a number of registered voters of the county equal to at least
- 25 five percent of the votes received in the county in the most recent
- 26 gubernatorial general election.
- 27 (b) A proposal described by Subsection (a) must describe the

- 1 boundaries of the proposed zone with sufficient definiteness to
- 2 identify with ordinary and reasonable certainty the area included
- 3 in the zone.
- 4 Sec. 328.024. PRELIMINARY PLAN FOR FEES. Before conducting
- 5 a public hearing under Section 328.025, the commissioners court
- 6 must prepare a preliminary plan for the use of zone fees that the
- 7 county may impose.
- 8 <u>Sec. 328.025. PUBLIC HEARING. (a) A commissioners court</u>
- 9 that adopts a proposal to designate a zone must hold a public
- 10 hearing on the proposal and the preliminary plan for fees at which
- 11 members of the public are given the opportunity to be heard.
- 12 (b) The commissioners court must hold the hearing not
- 13 earlier than the 20th day or later than the 40th day after the date
- 14 the commissioners court adopts the proposal designating the zone.
- 15 (c) The county must publish notice of the public hearing in
- 16 a newspaper of general circulation in the county at least once each
- 17 week during the two weeks preceding the date of the hearing.
- 18 Sec. 328.026. ELECTION. (a) Following the public hearing
- 19 held under Section 328.025, the commissioners court shall order an
- 20 election on the question of designating the zone if the
- 21 commissioners court finds that the designation will serve the
- 22 purpose prescribed by Section 328.022.
- 23 (b) A commissioners court that orders an election under this
- 24 section must order the election to be held on the first uniform
- 25 election date that falls on or after the 78th day after the date the
- 26 public hearing is held.
- (c) The order calling the election must allow voters in the

- 1 <u>county to vote for or against the designation of the proposed zone.</u>
- 2 (d) A county that holds an election under this section must
- 3 hold the election in the same manner as a general election of the
- 4 county.
- 5 Sec. 328.027. DESIGNATION OF ZONE. (a) The commissioners
- 6 court of a county in which the voters approve the designation of the
- 7 zone at an election held under this subchapter shall designate the
- 8 area as a zone.
- 9 (b) Not later than the fifth day after the date the
- 10 commissioners court adopts the order described by Section 328.026,
- 11 the county must send notice of the designation to the commissioners
- 12 <u>court of each county authorized to designate a zone un</u>der this
- 13 chapter.
- 14 SUBCHAPTER C. COUNTY WATER RECREATION SAFETY ZONE FEE
- 15 Sec. 328.041. COUNTY WATER RECREATION SAFETY ZONE FEE.
- 16 (a) A commissioners court that has designated a zone under
- 17 Subchapter B may impose a county water recreation safety zone fee in
- 18 the zone as provided by this section.
- 19 (b) The commissioners court may impose the fee on:
- 20 (1) the rental of water-oriented recreational
- 21 equipment;
- 22 (2) the provision of shuttle service related to
- 23 water-oriented recreational activities:
- 24 (A) in the zone; or
- 25 (B) into or out of the zone; and
- 26 (3) a service for ingress or egress to a river
- 27 described by Section 328.001 that is located in the zone.

- 1 (c) The commissioners court may impose different fee rates
- 2 for different types of water-oriented recreational equipment or
- 3 services for which the county is authorized to impose the fee. The
- 4 commissioners court may not impose the fee at a rate greater than
- 5 four dollars per person for each:
- 6 (1) rental of water-oriented recreational equipment
- 7 <u>in the zone; or</u>
- 8 (2) if the person does not rent water-oriented
- 9 recreational equipment in the zone:
- 10 (A) use of a shuttle service described by
- 11 Subsection (b)(2); or
- 12 (B) service for ingress or egress to a river
- 13 described by Section 328.001 that is located in the zone.
- 14 (d) The commissioners court by order shall establish:
- 15 (1) procedures and deadlines for a person who collects
- 16 a fee under this subchapter to report and remit the fee;
- 17 (2) penalties and interest for failure to timely remit
- 18 a fee collected under this subchapter; and
- 19 (3) any other requirement necessary for the
- 20 administration of the fee imposed under this section.
- Sec. 328.042. EXEMPTION. A county may not impose the fee
- 22 authorized by this subchapter on a transaction to which the United
- 23 States or this state is a party.
- Sec. 328.043. COLLECTION AND REMITTANCE OF FEE. (a) A
- 25 person who rents water-oriented recreational equipment under
- 26 Section 328.041(b)(1) to another person or who provides a service
- 27 described by Section 328.041(b)(2) or (3) to that person shall

- 1 collect the fee imposed under this subchapter from the other person
- 2 and shall report and remit the fee to the county in the manner
- 3 prescribed by the county.
- 4 (b) A person responsible for collecting the fee is liable to
- 5 the county for the amount of the fee required to be collected under
- 6 this section.
- 7 Sec. 328.044. COUNTY WATER RECREATION SAFETY ZONE FUND.
- 8 (a) A county in which the commissioners court has designated a
- 9 zone under Subchapter B must create and maintain a county water
- 10 recreation safety zone fund as a separate account in a depository
- 11 authorized to accept deposits of county public funds.
- 12 (b) The county shall deposit all fee revenue remitted to the
- 13 county under this subchapter to the credit of the fund.
- 14 <u>(c) A county may not use fee revenue deposited to the credit</u>
- 15 of the fund for a purpose other than the purpose prescribed by
- 16 <u>Section 328.045.</u>
- Sec. 328.045. USE OF FEE REVENUE. A county may use fee
- 18 revenue deposited in the fund only to employ or contract with
- 19 additional peace officers, as defined by Article 2.12, Code of
- 20 Criminal Procedure, to provide law enforcement in the zone.
- 21 SUBCHAPTER D. DISSOLUTION OF ZONE
- Sec. 328.061. DISSOLUTION OF ZONE. (a) The commissioners
- 23 court of a county that has designated a zone under Subchapter B:
- 24 (1) may propose the dissolution of the zone on the
- 25 commissioners court's own motion; and
- 26 (2) shall propose the dissolution of the zone if the
- 27 county clerk receives a written petition for the dissolution of the

- 1 zone signed by a number of the registered voters of the county equal
- 2 to at least 10 percent of the votes received in the county in the
- 3 most recent gubernatorial general election.
- 4 (b) A commissioners court that adopts a proposal for the
- 5 dissolution of a zone must hold a public hearing on the proposal in
- 6 the manner prescribed by Section 328.025.
- 7 (c) After the public hearing, the commissioners court shall
- 8 order the dissolution of the zone if the commissioners court finds
- 9 that the dissolution is in the best interest of the county.
- 10 SUBCHAPTER E. EXPIRATION OF AUTHORITY TO DESIGNATE ZONE
- 11 Sec. 328.081. EXPIRATION OF AUTHORITY TO DESIGNATE ZONE. A
- 12 commissioners court may not designate a zone under this chapter
- 13 after August 31, 2019, if the commissioners court has not
- 14 designated a zone before that date.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
