## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to peace officer enforcement of federal immigration law at places of worship, hospitals, public schools, and courthouses. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Code of Criminal Procedure, is amended by adding Article 2.255 to read as follows: 6 7 Art. 2.255. ENFORCEMENT OF FEDERAL IMMIGRATION LAW $\mathbf{AT}$ PLACES OF WORSHIP, HOSPITALS, PUBLIC SCHOOLS, AND COURTHOUSES. (a) 8 <u>A law enforcement agency or other governmental entity that employs</u> 9 a peace officer shall adopt and enforce a policy that prohibits the 10 agency's or entity's peace officers from participating in the 11 enforcement of federal laws relating to immigrants or immigration, 12 including the federal Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 13 Section 1101 et seq.), on the property of a place of worship, 14 hospital, public school, including a public institution of higher 15 16 education, or courthouse. (b) The attorney general, in consultation with agencies and 17 entities described by Subsection (a), shall develop and publish a 18 model policy on the attorney general's Internet website for the 19 enforcement of federal immigration law at places of worship, 20 hospitals, public schools, and courthouses to ensure that those 21 facilities remain safe and accessible to all residents of this 22 23 state regardless of immigration status. 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
