- 4 SECTION 1. Section 548.052, Transportation Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 548.052. VEHICLES NOT SUBJECT TO INSPECTION. This
- 7 chapter does not apply to:
- 8 (1) a trailer, semitrailer, pole trailer, or mobile
- 9 home moving under or bearing a current factory-delivery license
- 10 plate or current in-transit license plate;
- 11 (2) a vehicle moving under or bearing a paper dealer
- 12 in-transit tag, machinery license, disaster license, parade
- 13 license, prorate tab, one-trip permit, vehicle temporary transit
- 14 permit, antique license, custom vehicle license, street rod
- 15 license, temporary 24-hour permit, or permit license;
- 16 (3) a trailer, semitrailer, pole trailer, or mobile
- 17 home having an actual gross weight or registered gross weight of
- 18 $\frac{7,500}{1}$ [4,500] pounds or less;
- 19 (4) farm machinery, road-building equipment, a farm
- 20 trailer, or a vehicle required to display a slow-moving-vehicle
- 21 emblem under Section 547.703;
- 22 (5) a former military vehicle, as defined by Section
- 23 504.502;
- 24 (6) a vehicle qualified for a tax exemption under

- 1 Section 152.092, Tax Code; or
- 2 (7) a vehicle for which a certificate of title has been
- 3 issued but that is not required to be registered.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
