A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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2 relating to accounting principles applicable to pension and other
3 postemployment benefit expenses for electric utilities.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 36.065(b), Utilities Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

7 (b) <u>An</u> [Effective January 1, 2005, an] electric utility may 8 establish one or more reserve accounts for expenses for pension and 9 other postemployment benefits. An electric utility shall 10 periodically record in the reserve account any difference between:

(1) the 11 annual amount of pension and other 12 postemployment benefits approved as an [operating] expense in the 13 electric utility's last general rate proceeding or, if that amount cannot be determined from the regulatory authority's order, the 14 15 amount recorded for pension and other postemployment benefits under generally accepted accounting principles during the first year that 16 17 rates from the electric utility's last general rate proceeding are in effect; and 18

19 (2) the annual amount of pension and other 20 postemployment benefits as determined by actuarial or other similar 21 studies that are chargeable to the electric utility's [operating] 22 expense.

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
