1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to authorization for the conveyance of certain real
 1-18 property from Texas Tech University to Texas Tech University Health
 1-19 Sciences Center.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 109, Education Code, is
 1-22 amended by adding Section 109.0541 to read as follows:

1-23 Sec. 109.0541. AUTHORIZATION FOR CONVEYANCE OF CERTAIN
 1-24 TEXAS TECH UNIVERSITY REAL PROPERTY TO TEXAS TECH UNIVERSITY HEALTH
 1-25 SCIENCES CENTER. Notwithstanding Section 109.054, the board may
 1-26 execute a conveyance of real property that is part of the original
 1-27 main campus of Texas Tech University in Lubbock, Lubbock County, to
 1-28 Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center under terms and
 1-29 conditions that the board determines are in the best interest of
 1-30 both institutions. The transaction must be in the form of an
 1-31 agreement and appropriate conveyancing documents between the two
 1-32 institutions.

1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-34 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-35 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-36 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-37 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
