Section 501.072, Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 501.072. ODOMETER DISCLOSURE STATEMENT. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (c), the transferor [seller] of a motor 8 vehicle sold in this state shall provide to the transferee [buyer, 9 on a form prescribed by the department,] a [written] disclosure of 10 the vehicle's odometer reading at the time of the transfer in 11 12 compliance with 49 C.F.R. Part 580 [sale. The form must include space for the signature and printed name of both the seller and 13 14 buyer]. When application for a [certificate of] title is made, (b) 15 16 the transferee [owner] shall record the [current] odometer reading The [written] disclosure required by 17 on the application. Subsection (a) must accompany the application. 18 (c) An odometer disclosure statement is not required for the 19 sale of a motor vehicle that is exempt from odometer disclosure 20 requirements under 49 C.F.R. Section 580.17 [+ 21 [(1) has a manufacturer's rated carrying capacity 22 of 23 more than two tons; 24 [(2) is not self-propelled;

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1	[(3) is 10 or more years old;
2	[(4) is sold directly by the manufacturer to an agency
3	of the United States government in conformity with contractual
4	specifications; or
5	[(5) is a new motor vehicle].
6	SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 501, Transportation Code,
7	is amended by adding Section 501.077 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 501.077. ELECTRONIC FORMS; VERIFICATION. (a) The
9	department shall provide in electronic format and for use
10	consistent with 49 C.F.R. Part 580:
11	(1) a secure power of attorney form; and
12	(2) a secure reassignment form for licensed motor
13	vehicle dealers.
14	(b) This section does not require the department to certify
15	an electronic signature process or an electronic signature vendor
16	before accepting a form described by Subsection (a) that is
17	executed with an electronic signature.
18	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
