1-19 relating to the investigation of an anonymous report of suspected
1-20 abuse or neglect of a child.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section [261.304\(b\)](#), Family Code, is amended to
1-23 read as follows:

1-24 (b) An investigation under this section may include a visit
1-25 to the child's home, unless the alleged abuse or neglect can be
1-26 confirmed or clearly ruled out without a home visit, ~~and~~ an
1-27 interview with and examination of the child, and an interview with
1-28 the child's parents. In addition, the department may interview any
1-29 other person the department believes may have relevant information.

1-30 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
