- 8 Sec. 2.08. ACTION ON CERTIFICATION OF UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES.
- 9 (a) On receipt of the certification required by Section 2.052,
- 10 Election Code, the board may declare each unopposed candidate for
- 11 the board elected to the office.
- (b) If a declaration is made under Subsection (a), the
- 13 election is not held for that candidate's voting district.
- 14 (c) The ballots used at a separate election held at the same
- 15 time as an election that would have been held if the candidates were
- 16 not declared elected under this section shall include the offices
- 17 and names of the candidates declared elected under this section
- 18 listed separately after the measures or contested races in the
- 19 <u>separate election under the heading "Unopposed Candidates Declared</u>
- 20 Elected." The candidates shall be grouped in the same relative
- 21 order prescribed for the ballot generally. No votes are cast in
- 22 connection with the candidates.

- 1 system or ballot style and to facilitate the efficient and
- 2 <u>cost-effective implementation of this section.</u>
- 3 (e) A certificate of election shall be issued to each
- 4 candidate in the same manner and at the same time as provided for a
- 5 candidate elected at the election. The candidate must qualify for
- 6 the office in the same manner as provided for a candidate elected at
- 7 the election.
- 8 (f) Section 2.053, Election Code, does not apply to an
- 9 election for the board of directors of the authority.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
