- 4 SECTION 1. Section 1602.254, Occupations Code, is amended
- 5 by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:

- 7 (b)(3) may be fulfilled wholly or partly through credit hours. The
- 8 commission by rule shall establish a method for fairly equating
- 9 credit hours with clock hours of instruction.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 1603.102, Occupations Code, is amended
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 1603.102. SANITATION RULES. (a) The commission shall
- 13 establish sanitation rules to prevent the spread of an infectious

- 15 (b) The rules adopted under this section applicable to an

- 9 SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 10 1603.256(c), Occupations Code, applies only to a practical
- 11 examination administered on or after September 1, 2018.
- 12 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
