1 (6) a vehicle qualified for a tax exemption under Section 152.092, Tax Code; [or] 2 (7) a vehicle for which a certificate of title has been 3 4 issued but that is not required to be registered; or 5 (8) a vehicle that: 6 (A) is not domiciled in this state; 7 (B) is registered in this state or under the International Registration Plan as authorized by Section 502.091; 8 9 and (C) has been issued a certificate of inspection 10 in compliance with federal motor carrier safety regulations. 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 13

provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
