A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to parental rights regarding a student's participation in
- 3 human sexuality instruction in public schools.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.004, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (i), (i-1), and (j) and adding Subsections
- 7 (i-2) and (j-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (i) Before each school year, a school district shall provide
- 9 written notice to a parent of each student enrolled in the district
- 10 of the board of trustees' decision regarding whether the district
- 11 will provide human sexuality instruction to district students. If
- 12 instruction will be provided, the notice must include:
- 13 (1) a summary of the basic content of the district's
- 14 human sexuality instruction to be provided to the student,
- 15 including a statement informing the parent of the instructional
- 16 requirements under state law;
- 17 (2) a statement of the parent's right to:
- 18 (A) review or request a copy of curriculum
- 19 materials as provided by Subsection (j); and
- 20 (B) <u>refuse consent for [remove]</u> the student <u>to</u>
- 21 receive all or [from] any part of the district's human sexuality
- 22 instruction without subjecting the student to any disciplinary
- 23 action, academic penalty, or other sanction imposed by the district
- 24 or the student's school; and

- 1 (3) information describing the opportunities for
- 2 parental involvement in the development of the curriculum to be
- 3 used in human sexuality instruction, including information
- 4 regarding the local school health advisory council established
- 5 under Subsection (a).
- 6 (i-1) A parent may use the grievance procedure adopted under
- 7 Section 26.011 concerning a complaint of a violation of Subsection
- 8 (i) or (i-2).
- 9 (i-2) Before a student may be provided with human sexuality
- 10 instruction, a school district must obtain the written consent of
- 11 the student's parent. A request for written consent under this
- 12 subsection:
- 13 (1) may not be included with any other notification or
- 14 request for written consent provided to the parent, other than the
- 15 notice provided under Subsection (i); and
- 16 (2) must be provided to the parent not later than the
- 17 14th day before the date on which the human sexuality instruction
- 18 begins.
- 19 (j) A school district shall:
- 20 <u>(1)</u> make all curriculum materials used in the
- 21 district's human sexuality instruction available for reasonable
- 22 public inspection; and
- 23 (2) on request by a parent of a student enrolled in the
- 24 district, provide to the parent a copy of all curriculum materials
- 25 used in the district's human sexuality instruction.
- 26 <u>(j-1)</u> A school district may charge a reasonable fee in
- 27 accordance with Subchapter F, Chapter 552, Government Code, for

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- 1 copies of curriculum materials provided to a parent under
- 2 Subsection (j).
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
- 4 school year.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
