1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to an annual report on employment positions provided
 1-20 through the Texas college work-study program.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 56.082, Education Code, is amended to
 1-23 read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 56.082. ANNUAL [BIENNIAL] REPORT. [~~(a)~~] Not later
 1-25 than January 1 of each [~~odd-numbered~~] year, the Texas Higher
 1-26 Education Coordinating Board shall submit to the governor, the
 1-27 lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of representatives,
 1-28 and the standing legislative committees with primary jurisdiction
 1-29 over higher education and post on the coordinating board's Internet
 1-30 website a report on the Texas college work-study program. The
 1-31 report must include the total number of students employed through
 1-32 the program, disaggregated by:

- 1-33 (1) race, ethnicity, and gender;
- 1-34 (2) major and certificate or degree program;
- 1-35 (3) classification as a freshman, sophomore, junior,
 1-36 or senior or the equivalent;
- 1-37 (4) enrollment in a full course load or less than a
 1-38 full course load, as determined by the coordinating board;
- 1-39 (5) the employment position's location on or off
 1-40 campus; and
- 1-41 (6) [~~(2)~~] the employer's status as a for-profit or
 1-42 nonprofit entity.

1-43 [~~(b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), the Texas Higher~~
 1-44 ~~Education Coordinating Board shall submit its initial report under~~
 1-45 ~~that subsection not later than May 1, 2019. This subsection expires~~
 1-46 ~~September 1, 2019.]~~

1-47 SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2018, the Texas
 1-48 Higher Education Coordinating Board shall submit its initial report
 1-49 required under Section 56.082, Education Code, as amended by this
 1-50 Act.

1-51 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-52 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-53 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-54 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-55 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
