Section 54.2001, Education Code, is amended by 6 7 amending Subsection (g) to read as follows: 8 (g) This section does not apply to: (1) the waiver provided by Section 54.216 or any other 9 10 reduction in tuition provided to a high school student for enrollment in a dual credit course or other course for which the 11 12 student may earn joint high school and college credit; 13 (2) the exemption provided by Section 14 54.341(a-2)(1)(A), (B), (C), or (D) or (b)(1)(A), (B), (C), or (D); 15 (3) the exemption provided by Section 54.342, [or-] 54.366, or 54.367; or 16 any provision of this code that authorizes or 17 (4) requires the payment of tuition or fees at the rates provided for 18 residents of this state by a person who is not a resident of this 19 state for purposes of Subchapter B. 20 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
