- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 12A.003(b), Education Code, is amended
- to read as follows: 6
- 7 (b) A local innovation plan must:
- (1) provide for a comprehensive educational program 8
- 9 for the district, which program may include:
- 10 (A) innovative curriculum, instructional
- methods, and provisions regarding community participation, campus 11
- 12 governance, and parental involvement;
- 13 (B) except as provided by Section 12A.004(a),
- 14 modifications to the school day or year;
- provisions regarding the district budget and 15 (C)
- 16 sustainable program funding;
- accountability and assessment measures that 17 (D)
- exceed the requirements of state and federal law; and 18
- (E) any other innovations prescribed by the board 19
- 20 of trustees; and
- 21 identify requirements imposed by this code that
- inhibit the goals of the plan and from which the district should be 22
- 23 exempted on adoption of the plan, subject to Section 12A.004.
- SECTION 2. Section 12A.004(a), Education Code, is amended 2.4

- 1 to read as follows:
- 2 (a) A local innovation plan may not provide for the
- 3 exemption of a district designated as a district of innovation from
- 4 the following provisions of this title:
- 5 (1) a state or federal requirement applicable to an
- 6 open-enrollment charter school operating under Subchapter D,
- 7 Chapter 12;
- 8 (2) Subchapters A, C, D, and E, Chapter 11, except that
- 9 a district may be exempt from Sections 11.1511(b)(5) and (14) and
- 10 Section 11.162;
- 11 (3) state curriculum and graduation requirements
- 12 adopted under Chapter 28; [and]
- 13 (4) academic and financial accountability and
- 14 sanctions under Chapter 39; and
- 15 (5) the first day of instruction requirement under
- 16 <u>Section 25.0811</u>.
- SECTION 3. Section 25.0811(a), Education Code, is amended
- 18 to read as follows:
- 19 (a) Except as provided by this section, a school district
- 20 may not begin instruction for students for a school year before the
- 21 <u>Tuesday after Labor Day</u> [the fourth Monday in August]. A school
- 22 district may:
- 23 (1) begin instruction for students for a school year
- 24 before the Tuesday after Labor Day [the fourth Monday in August] if
- 25 the district operates a year-round system under Section 25.084; or
- 26 (2) begin instruction for students for a school year
- 27 on or after the first Monday in August at a campus or at not more

- 1 than 20 percent of the campuses in the district if:
- 2 (A) the district has a student enrollment of
- 3 190,000 or more;
- 4 (B) the district at the beginning of the school
- 5 year provides, financed with local funds, days of instruction for
- 6 students at the campus or at each of the multiple campuses, in
- 7 addition to the minimum [number of days of] instruction time
- 8 required under Section 25.081;
- 9 (C) the campus or each of the multiple campuses
- $10 \text{ } \underline{\text{is}} \text{ } [\text{are}]$ undergoing comprehensive reform, as determined by the
- 11 board of trustees of the district; and
- 12 (D) a majority of the students at the campus or at
- 13 each of the multiple campuses are educationally disadvantaged.
- 14 SECTION 4. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- 15 section, this Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018 school year.
- 16 (b) Sections 12A.003 and 12A.004, Education Code, as
- 17 amended by this Act, apply only to a local innovation plan adopted
- 18 or renewed on or after the effective date of this Act. A local
- 19 innovation plan adopted or renewed before the effective date of
- 20 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the plan was
- 21 adopted or renewed, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 22 that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
