Section 12A.003, Education Code, is amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as 6 7 follows: A local innovation plan must: 8 (b) 9 (1)provide for a comprehensive educational program for the district, which program may include: 10 11 (A) innovative curriculum, instructional 12 methods, and provisions regarding community participation, campus governance, and parental involvement; 13 14 (B) except as provided by Section 12A.004(a), modifications to the school day or year; 15 16 (C) provisions regarding the district budget and sustainable program funding; 17 18 accountability and assessment measures that (D) exceed the requirements of state and federal law; and 19 20 (E) any other innovations prescribed by the board 21 of trustees; and 22 (2) identify requirements imposed by this code that 23 inhibit the goals of the plan and from which the district should be exempted on adoption of the plan, subject to Section 12A.004. 24

1 (c) A school district designated as a district of innovation before June 1, 2017, may include modifications to the school year in 2 3 the local innovation plan. 4 SECTION 2. Section 12A.004, Education Code, is amended by 5 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as 6 follows: 7 (a) A local innovation plan may not provide for the 8 exemption of a district designated as a district of innovation from the following provisions of this title: 9 10 (1) a state or federal requirement applicable to an open-enrollment charter school operating under Subchapter D, 11 12 Chapter 12; Subchapters A, C, D, and E, Chapter 11, except that 13 (2) 14 a district may be exempt from Sections 11.1511(b)(5) and (14) and 15 Section 11.162; 16 (3) state curriculum and graduation requirements 17 adopted under Chapter 28; [and] (4) academic and financial 18 accountability and 19 sanctions under Chapter 39; and (5) the first day of instruction requirement under 20 Section 25.0811. 21 (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, 22 the local innovation plan of a school district designated as a 23 24 district of innovation before June 1, 2017, may provide for the exemption of the district from the first day of instruction 25 26 requirement under Section 25.0811. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 27

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
