A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to a prohibition on converting high occupancy vehicle
- 3 highway lanes to tolled lanes.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 228.201, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 228.201. LIMITATION ON TOLL FACILITY DESIGNATION.
- 8 [(a)] The department may not operate a nontolled state highway or
- 9 a segment of a nontolled state highway as a toll project, and may
- 10 not transfer a highway or segment to another entity for operation as
- 11 a toll project, unless:
- 12 (1) the commission by order designated the highway or
- 13 segment as a toll project before the contract to construct the
- 14 highway or segment was awarded;
- 15 (2) the project was designated as a toll project in a
- 16 plan or program of a metropolitan planning organization on or
- 17 before September 1, 2005;
- 18 (3) the highway or segment is reconstructed so that
- 19 the number of nontolled lanes on the highway or segment is greater
- 20 than or equal to the number in existence before the reconstruction;
- 21 <u>or</u>
- 22 (4) a facility is constructed adjacent to the highway
- 23 or segment so that the number of nontolled lanes on the converted
- 24 highway or segment and the adjacent facility together is greater

- 1 than or equal to the number in existence on the converted highway or
- 2 segment before the conversion[; or
- 3 [(5) subject to Subsection (b), the highway or segment
- 4 was open to traffic as a high-occupancy vehicle lane on May 1,
- 5 2005].
- 6 [(b) The department may operate or transfer a
- 7 high-occupancy vehicle lane under Subsection (a)(5) as a tolled
- 8 lane only if the department or other entity operating the lane
- 9 allows vehicles occupied by a specified number of passengers to use
- 10 the lane without paying a toll.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
