1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to providing for the review of certain county departments  
 1-22 of education by the Sunset Advisory Commission.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. (a) The county department of education in a  
 1-25 county with a population of four million or more according to the  
 1-26 most recent federal decennial census is subject to review under  
 1-27 Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act), as if the  
 1-28 department were a state agency, but the department may not be  
 1-29 abolished under that chapter. The review shall be conducted as if  
 1-30 the department were scheduled to be abolished September 1, 2019.

1-31 (b) The review must assess the department's governance,  
 1-32 management, and operating structure, and the department's  
 1-33 compliance with legislative requirements.

1-34 (c) The department shall pay the cost incurred by the Sunset  
 1-35 Advisory Commission in performing a review of the department under  
 1-36 this section. The Sunset Advisory Commission shall determine the  
 1-37 cost, and the department shall pay the amount promptly on receipt of  
 1-38 a statement from the Sunset Advisory Commission detailing the cost.

1-39 (d) This Act expires September 1, 2021.

1-40 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
