4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 25, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 25.15 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 25.15. TRANSFER OF BEVERAGES. (a) This section
8	applies only to a wine and beer retailer's permit holder who holds
9	permits for not more than five noncontiguous permitted premises
10	located in a facility that is:
11	(1) operated for public entertainment involving
12	waterslides, food service, music, and amusement activities; and
13	(2) located primarily along the banks of the Comal
14	<u>River.</u>
15	(b) Notwithstanding any other law, the holder of the wine
16	and beer retailer's permits described by Subsection (a) may
17	transfer alcoholic beverages between the permitted premises in the
18	facility described by Subsection (a) and another permitted facility
19	that is:
20	(1) operated by the permit holder; and
21	(2) located in the same county as the facility
22	described by Subsection (a).
23	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
