A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to community outreach on the dangers of abusable synthetic
3	substances.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 6, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 469 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 469. ABUSABLE SYNTHETIC SUBSTANCES COMMUNITY OUTREACH
8	Sec. 469.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
9	(1) "Abusable synthetic substance" has the meaning
10	assigned by Section 484.001.
11	(2) "Task force" means the abusable synthetic
12	substances education task force created under this chapter.
13	Sec. 469.002. ABUSABLE SYNTHETIC SUBSTANCES EDUCATION TASK
14	FORCE. (a) The abusable synthetic substances education task force
15	is composed of:
16	(1) the commissioner of the Texas Education Agency or
17	the commissioner's designee;
18	(2) the executive director of the Texas Department of
19	Criminal Justice or the executive director's designee;
20	(3) the executive director of the Texas Juvenile
21	Justice Department or the executive director's designee;
22	(4) the public safety director of the Department of
23	Public Safety or the director's designee;
24	(5) the executive commissioner of the Health and Human

- 1 Services Commission or the executive commissioner's designee; and
- 2 (6) the associate commissioner for intellectual and
- 3 developmental disabilities and behavioral health services of the
- 4 medical and social services division of the Health and Human
- 5 Services Commission or the associate commissioner's designee.
- 6 (b) The members of the task force shall elect a presiding
- 7 officer from among the membership.
- 8 (c) Members of the task force serve without compensation and
- 9 may not be reimbursed for travel or other expenses incurred while
- 10 conducting the business of the task force.
- 11 (d) The task force shall meet at the call of the presiding
- 12 officer. The task force may meet telephonically in accordance with
- 13 Section 551.125(b)(3), Government Code.
- 14 (e) Each agency represented on the task force shall
- 15 contribute resources to the task force.
- Sec. 469.003. COMMUNITY OUTREACH CAMPAIGN. (a) The task
- 17 force shall develop and implement a community outreach campaign
- 18 that educates the public about and increases awareness of the
- 19 dangers of abusable synthetic substances.
- 20 (b) The community outreach campaign shall address:
- 21 (1) the health, criminal, and social consequences of
- 22 using an abusable synthetic substance;
- (2) recognizing the packaging of abusable synthetic
- 24 substances;
- 25 (3) recognizing the signs of abusable synthetic
- 26 substance use;
- 27 (4) responding to a possible overdose of or adverse

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- 1 reaction to the ingestion of an abusable synthetic substance; and
- 2 (5) treatment options for persons using abusable
- 3 synthetic substances.
- 4 (c) The community outreach campaign must be designed to
- 5 reach a broad audience, but also contain elements specifically
- 6 designed for students and youth.
- 7 (d) The task force may:
- 8 <u>(1) publish and make available written materials on</u>
- 9 the dangers of abusable synthetic substances;
- 10 (2) use advertisements or similar media to provide
- 11 information on the dangers of abusable synthetic substances and
- 12 <u>increase community awareness; and</u>
- 13 (3) create and maintain an Internet website containing
- 14 information on the dangers of abusable synthetic substances.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
