6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 191, Health and Safety
7	Code, is amended by adding Section 191.009 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 191.009. DEATH INFORMATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC
9	SAFETY. (a) The department shall implement an efficient and
10	effective method to verify death information to assist the
11	Department of Public Safety with maintaining records of holders of
12	driver's licenses and personal identification certificates in this
13	state.
14	(b) The department shall enter into a memorandum of
15	understanding with the Department of Public Safety to implement
16	this section. The memorandum of understanding must include a
17	mechanism for the department to provide to the Department of Public
18	Safety death information that includes unique identifiers,
19	including social security numbers, necessary to accurately match
20	death records with driver's license and personal identification
21	certificate records.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
