- 6 this Act. A suit filed under Chapter 45, Title 1, Title 4, or Title
- 7 5, Family Code, before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 8 the law in effect on the date the suit was filed, and the former law
- 9 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
