- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 643.002, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 643.002. EXEMPTIONS. This chapter does not apply to:
- 8 (1) motor carrier operations exempt from registration
- 9 by the Unified Carrier Registration Act of 2005 (49 U.S.C. Section
- 10 14504a) or a motor vehicle registered under the single state
- 11 registration system established under federal law [49 U.S.C.
- 12 Section 14504(c)] when operating exclusively in interstate or
- 13 international commerce;
- 14 (2) a motor vehicle registered as a cotton vehicle
- 15 under Section 504.505;
- 16 (3) a motor vehicle the department by rule exempts
- 17 because the vehicle is subject to comparable registration and a
- 18 comparable safety program administered by another governmental
- 19 entity;
- 20 (4) a motor vehicle used to transport passengers
- 21 operated by an entity whose primary function is not the
- 22 transportation of passengers, such as a vehicle operated by a
- 23 hotel, day-care center, public or private school, nursing home, or
- 24 similar organization;

- 1 (5) a vehicle operating under a private carrier permit
- 2 issued under Chapter 42, Alcoholic Beverage Code;
- 3 (6) a vehicle operated by a governmental entity; [or]
- 4 (7) a tow truck, as defined by Section 2308.002,
- 5 Occupations Code; or
- 6 (8) a passenger car or light truck, as those terms are
- 7 <u>defined by Section 541.201</u>, that is:
- 8 (A) transporting household goods; and
- 9 (B) operating exclusively in intrastate
- 10 commerce.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 643.051(b), Transportation Code, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (b) A motor carrier may not operate a vehicle to which this
- 14 <u>chapter applies</u>[, regardless of size of the vehicle,] to transport
- 15 household goods for compensation unless the carrier registers with
- 16 the department under this subchapter.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
