9	(a) An emergency communication district created under Chapter
10	772, Health and Safety Code, is entitled to obtain from the
11	department criminal history record information maintained by the
12	department that relates to a person who is:
13	(1) an applicant for employment by or an employee of
14	the district;
15	(2) an applicant for a volunteer position or a
16	volunteer with the district; or
17	(3) an applicant for employment by or an employee of a
18	person that contracts with the district.
19	(b) Criminal history record information obtained by an
20	emergency communication district under Subsection (a) may not be
21	released or disclosed to any person except:
22	(1) in a criminal proceeding;
23	(2) on court order; or
24	(3) with the consent of the person who is the subject
