BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 623.252(b), Transportation Code, amended to read as follows:

A permit issued under this subchapter may authorize: (b)

(1)the transport of cargo only on the following roads in Chambers County:

(A) Farm-to-Market 1405 Road between intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 2354 and its intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 565;

(B) [the frontage road of] State Highway 99, including the frontage road of State Highway 99 and the portion of the frontage road located in the Cedar Crossing Business and Industrial Park, other than a tolled segment of State Highway 99, between the [its] crossing of State Highway 99 with Cedar Bayou and into into reaction with Interest Highway 99 with Cedar Bayou and its intersection with Interstate Highway 10[, including the portion of the frontage road located in the Cedar Crossing Business and Industrial Park];

(C) 565 Farm-to-Market Road from its intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 1405 to its intersection with State Highway 99; and

(D) Farm-to-Market Road 2354 from its intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 1405 northwest approximately 300 linear feet to the termination of the state-maintained portion of the road; and

(2) the movement of equipment and commodities weighing 100,000 pounds or less.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
