A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to election of professional staff representatives to certain school district planning and decision-making committees.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 11.251, Education Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (e-1) to read as 7 follows:

The board shall adopt a procedure, consistent with 8 (e) 9 Subsection (e-1) and Section 21.407(a), for the professional staff in the district to nominate and elect the professional staff 10 11 representatives who shall meet with the board or the board designee as required under this section. At least two-thirds of the elected 12 staff representatives 13 professional must be classroom 14 teachers. The remaining staff representatives shall include both district-level professional staff members. 15 campus- and Τf 16 practicable, the committee membership shall include at least one professional staff representative with the primary responsibility 17 for educating students with disabilities. Board policy must 18 provide procedures for: 19

20 (1) the selection of parents to the district-level and21 campus-level committees; and

(2) the selection of community members and business representatives to serve on the district-level committee in a manner that provides for appropriate representation of the
