Section 411.086(b), Government Code, is amended 19 to read as follows: 20 21 (b) Rules adopted by the department: 22 (1) shall provide for a uniform method of requesting 23 criminal history record information from the department; 24 may require a person requesting criminal history (2)

No. 1299 record information about an individual to submit to the department 1 one or more of the following: 2 3 (A) the complete name, race, and sex of the 4 individual; 5 (B) any known alias name of the individual; 6 (C) complete set of the individual's а 7 fingerprints; 8 (D) a recent photograph of the individual; 9 (E) any known identifying number of the individual other than a social security number, including [social 10 security number, ] FBI number, driver's license number, or state 11 identification number; 12 (F) the individual's date of birth; 13 14 (G) any known alias dates of birth of the 15 individual; or 16 (H) any other information the department 17 determines is necessary to identify the individual or the record; shall provide for the methods and formats for 18 (3) dissemination of criminal history record information; and 19 20 shall provide security measures and policies that (4) are designed to guard against unauthorized release or dissemination 21 22 of criminal history record information that is maintained or 23 disseminated by the department. 24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
