- If the commission determines that the product tested 1 [analysis provided by the independent laboratory or the sample,] 2 and [the] label submitted under [required by] Subsection (a) 3 4 comply with the provisions of this code and the rules of the commission, the commission shall issue a certificate of approval 5 6 upon receipt of a fee in an amount that is sufficient to cover the cost of administering this section. A copy of the certificate 7 8 shall be kept on file in the office of the commission.
- 9 (e) The commission <u>may require proof by affidavit or</u>
 10 <u>otherwise that a laboratory performing a test</u> [by rule shall
 11 <u>establish the procedures for accepting analysis of beer, ale, or</u>
