A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to staff development in suicide prevention for public 3 school educators. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Sections 21.451(d), (d-1), and (d-2), Education Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 The staff development: 7 (d) (1) may include training in: 8 9 (A) technology; conflict resolution; 10 (B) discipline strategies, including classroom 11 (C) 12 management, district discipline policies, and the student code of conduct adopted under Section 37.001 and Chapter 37; and 13 14 (D) preventing, identifying, responding to, and reporting incidents of bullying; 15 subject to Subsection (e) and to Section 21.3541 16 (2) and rules adopted under that section, must include training that is 17 evidence-based [based on scientifically based research], 18 as defined by Section 8002(6), Every Student Succeeds Act [9101, No 19 Child Left Behind Act of 2001] (20 U.S.C. Section 7801), and that: 20 21 (A) relates to instruction of students with 22 disabilities; and 23 (B) is designed for educators who work primarily 24 outside the area of special education; and

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1 (3) <u>may</u> [must] include suicide prevention training
2 that <u>may</u> [must] be provided:

3 (A) on an annual basis, as part of a new employee
4 orientation, to all new school district and open-enrollment charter
5 school educators; and

6 (B) to existing school district and 7 open-enrollment charter school educators on a schedule adopted by 8 the agency by rule.

9 (d-1) The suicide prevention training <u>under</u> [required by] 10 Subsection (d)(3) <u>may</u> [must] use a best practice-based program 11 recommended by the Department of State Health Services in 12 coordination with the agency under Section 161.325, Health and 13 Safety Code.

14 (d-2) The suicide prevention training <u>under</u> [required by]
15 Subsection (d)(3) may be <u>provided</u> [satisfied] through independent
16 review of suicide prevention training material that:

17 (1) complies with the guidelines developed by the18 agency; and

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(2) is offered online.

20 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018 21 school year.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
