1-20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to the earliest day a public school teacher may be required
 1-23 to report for service.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 21, Education Code, is
 1-26 amended by adding Section 21.010 to read as follows:

1-27 Sec. 21.010. FIRST DAY OF TEACHER SERVICE. (a) Except as
 1-28 provided by Subsection (b), a school district may not require a
 1-29 teacher to report for service at the beginning of a school year
 1-30 earlier than the seventh business day before the first day that
 1-31 instruction will be provided to students.

1-32 (b) A school district may require a teacher who is in the
 1-33 teacher's first year of employment with the district to report for
 1-34 service at the beginning of a school year up to 10 business days
 1-35 before the first day that instruction will be provided to students.

1-36 SECTION 2. Section 21.010, Education Code, as added by this
 1-37 Act, applies beginning with the 2018-2019 school year.

1-38 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
