8	INFORMATION: RAILROAD COMMISSION OF TEXAS. (a) The Railroad
9	Commission of Texas is entitled to obtain from the department, the

11	Services Division, or another law enforcement agency criminal

13	or agency that relates to a person who is:

20	Railroad Commission of Texas under Subsection (a) may be used only

23	(c) The Railroad Commission of Texas may not release or
24	disclose information obtained under Subsection (a) except on court

1 order or with the consent of the person who is the subject of the 2 criminal history record information.

3 <u>(d) After the expiration of any probationary term of the</u> 4 <u>person's employment or not later than the 180th day after the date</u> 5 <u>of receipt of the information, whichever is later, the Railroad</u> 6 <u>Commission of Texas shall destroy all criminal history record</u> 7 <u>information obtained under Subsection (a).</u>

8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
