## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to compensation of county auditors and assistant auditors.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 152.905, Local Government Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 6 (e) In setting the compensation for a county auditor or
- 7 assistant auditor considered at a hearing under this section, the
- 8 district judge or judges may not set the amount of compensation in
- 9 an amount that is inconsistent with a wage and position
- 10 classification plan adopted by the county.
- 11 SECTION 2. For a county auditor or assistant auditor
- 12 appointed before the effective date of this Act whose compensation
- 13 does not conform to the person's position classification as
- 14 provided by a wage and position classification plan adopted by the
- 15 county that the person serves, the district judge or judges, in
- 16 subsequent hearings setting the person's annual compensation,
- 17 shall, without reducing the person's annual compensation, align the
- 18 person's compensation with the wage and position classification
- 19 plan adopted by the county.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
