## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to payment for the use of a highway toll project.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 228.057, Transportation Code, is amended
5	by adding Subsection (i) to read as follows:
6	(i) The department shall provide electronic toll collection
7	customers with an option to authorize automatic payment of tolls
8	through the withdrawal of funds from the customer's bank account.
9	SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 372, Transportation Code,
10	is amended by adding Sections 372.054, 372.055, and 372.056 to read
11	as follows:
12	Sec. 372.054. DETERMINATION OF ELECTRONIC TOLL COLLECTION
13	CUSTOMER ACCOUNT BEFORE PAYMENT SOLICITATION. (a) A toll project
14	entity may not send an invoice or a notice of unpaid tolls to the
15	registered owner of a vehicle soliciting payment of a toll or any
16	related administrative fee unless the entity first determines
17	whether there is an active electronic toll collection customer
18	account that corresponds to a transponder issued for the vehicle.
19	(b) If a toll project entity determines under Subsection (a)
20	that there is a sufficiently funded electronic toll collection
21	customer account that corresponds to a transponder issued for the
22	vehicle, the entity must:
23	(1) satisfy the outstanding toll from the account at

the standard electronic collection rate and may not collect any

- 1 administrative fees or late fees; and
- 2 (2) if the entity determines that a transponder issued
- 3 to an electronic toll collection customer did not work correctly
- 4 more than 10 times in a 30-day period, send to the customer a notice
- 5 informing the customer that the transponder issued for the
- 6 customer's vehicle may not be working correctly.
- 7 Sec. 372.055. INFORMATION REQUIRED ON NOTICE OR INVOICE. A
- 8 notice or an invoice of unpaid tolls sent by a toll project entity
- 9 under Section 372.054 or any other section must clearly state that
- 10 the document is a bill and the recipient is expected to pay the
- 11 amount indicated.
- 12 Sec. 372.056. METHOD OF SENDING INVOICE OR NOTICE. An
- 13 invoice or notice provided to a person by a toll project entity
- 14 under this subchapter may be provided by:
- 15 (1) first class mail; or
- 16 (2) e-mail if the person has provided an e-mail
- 17 address to the entity and has elected to receive notice
- 18 electronically.
- 19 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 20 to the collection of a toll incurred on or after the effective date
- 21 of this Act. The collection of a toll incurred before the effective
- 22 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before
- 23 the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect
- 24 for that purpose.
- 25 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
