- 4 SECTION 1. Section 201.2042, Family Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (c) through (g) to

- 7 (b) The party requesting a de novo hearing before the
- 8 referring court shall file notice with the referring court, [and]
- 9 the clerk of the referring court, and the associate judge.
- 10 <u>(c) A party may not request a de novo hearing on a default</u>
- 11 judgment or an agreed order.
- 12 (d) A request for a de novo hearing under this section must
- 13 specify the issues to be presented to the referring court. If the
- 14 request for a de novo hearing fails to specify the issues, the
- 15 referring court shall deny the relief requested and refuse to
- 16 schedule a de novo hearing.
- 17 (e) Proceedings under this section shall be given
- 18 precedence over other pending matters to the extent necessary to
- 19 <u>ensure the court reaches a decision promptly.</u>
- 20 <u>(f) After notice to the parties, the referring court shall</u>

- 3 (g) Except as provided by Section 201.016, the date the
- 4 request for a de novo hearing is considered denied under Subsection
- 5 (f) is the controlling date for the purpose of an appeal to, or a
- 6 request for other relief from, a court of appeals or the supreme
- 7 court.
- 8 SECTION 2. Sections 201.014(b) and 201.2041(b), Family
- 9 Code, are repealed.
- 10 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 11 a request for a de novo hearing that is filed on or after the
- 12 effective date of this Act. A request for a de novo hearing filed
- 13 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 14 effect on the date the request was filed, and the former law is
- 15 continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
