- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 36, Insurance Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 36.007 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 36.007. RULES RELATING TO AGREEMENTS LIMITING STATE
- 9 AUTHORITY TO REGULATE INSURANCE PROHIBITED; EFFECT OF AGREEMENT.
- 10 (a) The commissioner may not adopt or enforce a rule that
- 11 implements an interstate, national, or international agreement
- 12 that:

- (1) infringes on the authority of this state to
- 14 regulate the business of insurance in this state; and
- 15 (2) was not approved by the legislature.
- (b) An agreement described by Subsection (a) has no effect
- 17 on the authority of this state to regulate the business of insurance
- in this state unless the agreement is approved by the legislature.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
