A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to maximum liability limits for windstorm and hail
- 3 insurance coverage provided through the Texas Windstorm Insurance

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 2210.501(a), Insurance Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The board of directors shall propose the maximum
- 9 liability limits under a windstorm and hail insurance policy issued
- 10 by the association under this chapter. The maximum liability
- 11 limits <u>are considered</u> [<u>must be</u>] approved by the commissioner <u>unless</u>
- 12 the commissioner disapproves or modifies the liability limits by
- 13 order issued not later than the 30th day after the date of receipt
- 14 of a filing under Section 2210.503.
- SECTION 2. Section 2210.504(a), Insurance Code, is amended
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 (a) Not later than the 30th [60th] day after the date the
- 18 <u>commissioner disapproves or modifies</u> [of receipt of] a filing under
- 19 Section 2210.503, and after notice and hearing, the commissioner by
- 20 order shall approve, disapprove, or modify the proposed adjustment
- 21 to the maximum liability limits.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 23 a proposed maximum liability limit filed on and after January 1,
- 24 2018. A proposed maximum liability limit filed before January 1,

- 1 2018, is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the
- 2 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 3 that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
