- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 37.11(a), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 (a) A person commits an offense if $\underline{\text{the person}}$ [$\underline{\text{he}}$]:
- 8 (1) impersonates a public servant with intent to
- 9 induce another to submit to the person's [his] pretended official
- 10 authority or to rely on the person's [his] pretended official acts;
- 11 [or]
- 12 (2) knowingly purports to exercise any function of a
- 13 public servant or of a public office, including that of a judge and
- 14 court, and the position or office through which the person [he]
- 15 purports to exercise a function of a public servant or public office
- 16 has no lawful existence under the constitution or laws of this state
- 17 or of the United States; or
- 18 (3) while serving as mediator or arbitrator, knowingly
- 19 represents to another person that the actor is or was a member of
- 20 the judiciary of this state, any other state, or the United States
- 21 or uses any of the titles "judge," "justice," or "honorable," if the
- 22 actor was not previously elected or appointed to be a member of the
- 23 judiciary of this state, any other state, or the United States.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
