Sections 45.0532(a), (a-1), and (b), Education 5 Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 In addition to the general limitation under Section 7 (a) 45.053, the commissioner may not approve charter district bonds for 8 9 guarantee under this subchapter in a total amount that exceeds the charter capacity [percentage of the total available capacity] of 10 11 the guaranteed bond program [that is equal to the percentage of the 12 number of students enrolled in open-enrollment charter schools in this state compared to the total number of students enrolled in all 13 14 public schools in this state, as determined by the commissioner]. (a-1) The commissioner may not approve charter district 15 16 refunding or refinanced bonds for guarantee under this subchapter in a total amount that exceeds one-half of the charter capacity 17 [total amount available for the guarantee of charter district bonds 18 under Subsection (a)]. 19 For purposes of this section [Subsection (a)], the 20 (b) charter [total available] capacity of the guaranteed bond program 21 is the percentage of the total capacity of the guaranteed bond 22

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program [limit] established by the board under Sections 45.053(d)

and 45.0531 that is equal to the percentage of the number of

students enrolled in open-enrollment charter schools in this state 1 2 compared to the total number of students enrolled in all public schools in this state, as determined by the commissioner [minus the 3 4 total amount of outstanding guaranteed bonds]. Each time the board increases the limit under Section 45.053(d), the total amount of 5 6 charter district bonds that may be guaranteed increases accordingly under Subsection (a). 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8

9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
