9	Sec. 32.301. ESTABLISHMENT OF PROGRAM. (a) The
10	commissioner may establish a grant program under which grants are
11	awarded to school districts and open-enrollment charter schools to
12	implement a technology lending program to provide students access
13	to equipment necessary to access and use electronic instructional
14	materials.
15	(b) A school district or an open-enrollment charter school
16	may apply to the commissioner to participate in the grant program.
17	In awarding grants under this subchapter for each school year, the
18	commissioner shall consider:
19	(1) the availability of existing equipment to students
20	in the district or school;
21	(2) other funding available to the district or school;
22	and
23	(3) the district's or school's technology plan.
24	(c) The commissioner may determine the terms of a grant

1	awarded under this section, including limits on the grant amount
2	and approved uses of grant funds.
3	(d) The commissioner may recover funds not used in
4	accordance with the terms of a grant by withholding amounts from any
5	state funds otherwise due to the school district or open-enrollment
6	charter school.
7	Sec. 32.302. FUNDING. (a) The commissioner may use not
8	more than \$25 million from the state instructional materials fund
9	under Section 31.021 each state fiscal biennium or a different
10	amount determined by appropriation to administer a grant program
11	established under this subchapter.
12	(b) The cost of administering a grant program under this
13	subchapter must be paid from funds described by Subsection (a).
14	Sec. 32.303. USE OF GRANT FUNDS. (a) A school district or
15	open-enrollment charter school may use a grant awarded under
16	Section 32.301 or other local funds to purchase, maintain, and
17	insure equipment for a technology lending program.
18	(b) Equipment purchased by a school district or
19	open-enrollment charter school with a grant awarded under Section
20	32.301 is the property of the district or school.
21	Sec. 32.304. REVIEW OF PROGRAM. Not later than January 1,
22	2019, the commissioner shall review the grant program established
23	under this subchapter and submit a report to the governor, the
24	lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of representatives,
25	and the presiding officers of the standing committees in the senate
26	and house primarily responsible for public education. This section
27	expires September 1, 2019.

1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
