AN ACT

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 36, Utilities Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 36.010 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 36.010. RATES FOR CERTAIN PLACES OF WORSHIP.
- 8 (a) This section only applies to a transmission and distribution
- 9 <u>utility that:</u>

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- 10 (1) on January 1, 2017, operated solely in ERCOT; and
- 11 (2) provides service to fewer than 100,000 meters.
- 12 (b) A transmission and distribution utility providing
- 13 service to a customer that is a nonprofit place of worship shall
- 14 <u>bill the customer on a kilowatt hour basis. If the customer has</u>
- 15 separately metered facilities, the utility shall bill each of those
- 16 facilities on a kilowatt hour basis if the facilities operate
- 17 primarily during off-peak periods.
- 18 <u>(c) The commission shall adopt rules necessary to</u>
- 19 <u>administer this section.</u>
- 20 SECTION 2. The Public Utility Commission of Texas shall
- 21 adopt rules as necessary to implement Section 36.010, Utilities
- 22 Code, as added by this Act, as soon as practicable. A transmission
- 23 and distribution utility shall modify its rates applicable to each
- 24 nonprofit place of worship in accordance with Section 36.010,

- 1 Utilities Code, as added by this Act, not later than January 1,
- 2 2018.
- 3 SECTION 3. (a) Notwithstanding any other law or agreement,
- 4 on the petition of a nonprofit place of worship, the Public Utility
- 5 Commission of Texas shall evaluate a charge for transmission or
- 6 distribution service charged by a transmission and distribution
- 7 utility to the place of worship on or after January 1, 2017, and
- 8 before January 1, 2018, to determine whether the charge complies
- 9 with Section 36.010, Utilities Code, as added by this Act.
- 10 (b) If the Public Utility Commission of Texas determines
- 11 under Subsection (a) of this section that the charge does not comply
- 12 with Section 36.010, Utilities Code, as added by this Act, the
- 13 commission:
- 14 (1) by order shall require the utility to refund to the
- 15 nonprofit place of worship money collected from the charge in
- 16 excess of the charge fixed under Section 36.010, Utilities Code, as
- 17 added by this Act; and
- 18 (2) may allow the place of worship to recover from the
- 19 utility any reasonable expenses incurred by the place of worship in
- 20 the process of submitting a petition under this section.
- 21 (c) This section expires and a nonprofit place of worship
- 22 may not submit a petition under this section after September 1,
- 23 2019.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
