1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1-20 AN ACT

> relating to rates charged by certain transmission and distribution utilities to certain places of worship.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 36, Utilities Code, is amended by adding Section 36.010 to read as follows:

Sec. 36.010. RATES FOR CERTAIN PLACES OF WORSHIP. This section only applies to a transmission and distribution utility that:

(1)on January 1, 2017, operated solely in ERCOT; and

- (2) provides service to fewer than 100,000 meters.

  (b) A transmission and distribution utility providing service to a customer that is a nonprofit place of worship shall If the customer has bill the customer on a kilowatt hour basis. separately metered facilities, the utility shall bill each of those facilities on a kilowatt hour basis if the facilities operate primarily during off-peak periods.

  (c) The commission shall adopt rules necessary to
- administer this section.

SECTION 2. The Public Utility Commission of Texas shall adopt rules as necessary to implement Section 36.010, Utilities Code, as added by this Act, as soon as practicable. A transmission and distribution utility shall modify its rates applicable to each nonprofit place of worship in accordance with Section 36.010, Utilities Code, as added by this Act, not later than January 1, 2018.

- SECTION 3. (a) Notwithstanding any other law or agreement, on the petition of a nonprofit place of worship, the Public Utility Commission of Texas shall evaluate a charge for transmission or distribution service charged by a transmission and distribution utility to the place of worship on or after September 1, 2017, and before January 1, 2018, to determine whether the charge complies with Section 36.010, Utilities Code, as added by this Act.
- If the Public Utility Commission of Texas determines under Subsection (a) of this section that the charge does not comply with Section 36.010, Utilities Code, as added by this Act, the commission:
