## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to continuing education requirements for noncertified

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 259.002, Health and
- 6 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 259.002. REQUIREMENTS FOR PRACTICING SURGICAL
- 8 TECHNOLOGY; CONTINUING EDUCATION.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 259.002, Health and Safety Code, is
- 10 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 11 (d) A person employed by a health care facility to practice
- 12 surgical technology under Subsection (a)(2) or (3) or Subsection
- 13 (c) shall complete fifteen hours of continuing education each year
- 14 and submit evidence of the satisfactory completion of the
- 15 continuing education to the facility. The facility may not
- 16 continue to employ the person if the person does not complete the
- 17 continuing education required by this subsection.
- SECTION 3. Notwithstanding Section 259.002(d), Health and
- 19 Safety Code, as added by this Act, a person employed by a health
- 20 care facility to practice surgical technology is not required to
- 21 complete the continuing education before September 1, 2018.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
