## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the eligibility of land for appraisal for ad valorem tax
- 3 purposes as qualified open-space land if the land is used for
- 4 certain oil and gas operations.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 23, Tax Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 23.524 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 23.524. OIL AND GAS OPERATIONS ON LAND. The
- 9 eligibility of land for appraisal under this subchapter does not
- 10 end because a lessee begins conducting oil and gas operations on the
- 11 <u>land under a lease over which the Railroad Commission of Texas has</u>
- 12 jurisdiction under Section 81.051, Natural Resources Code, if the
- 13 land otherwise continues to qualify for appraisal under this
- 14 subchapter.

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- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 16 affect an additional tax imposed as a result of a change of use of
- 17 land appraised under Subchapter D, Chapter 23, Tax Code, that
- 18 occurred before the effective date of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the date on which the
- 20 constitutional amendment proposed by the 85th Legislature, Regular
- 21 Session, 2017, authorizing the legislature to provide for
- 22 exceptions to the requirement that open-space land be devoted to
- 23 certain purposes for ad valorem taxation based on the land's
- 24 productive capacity is approved by the voters. If that amendment is

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1 not approved by the voters, this Act has no effect.
