- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 1053, Estates Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Sections 1053.053 and 1053.054 to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 Sec. 1053.053. EXEMPTION FROM GUARDIANSHIP PROCEEDING FEES
- 10 FOR CERTAIN MILITARY SERVICEMEMBERS. (a) In this section, "combat
- 11 zone" means an area that the president of the United States by
- 12 executive order designates for purposes of 26 U.S.C. Section 112 as
- 13 <u>an area in which armed forces of the United States are or have</u>
- 14 engaged in combat.
- 15 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the clerk of a county
- 16 court may not charge, or collect from, the estate of a proposed ward
- 17 or ward any of the following fees if the court finds that the
- 18 proposed ward or ward became incapacitated as a result of a personal
- 19 injury sustained while in active service as a member of the armed
- 20 forces of the <u>United States in a combat zone:</u>
- 21 (1) a fee for the filing of a guardianship proceeding;
- 22 and
- 23 (2) a fee for any service rendered by the court
- 24 regarding the administration of the guardianship.

- 4 Sec. 1053.054. EXEMPTION FROM GUARDIANSHIP FEES FOR CERTAIN
- 5 LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS, FIREFIGHTERS, AND OTHERS. (a) In this
- 6 section:
- 7 (1) "Eligible proposed ward" or "eligible ward" means
- 8 an individual listed in Section 615.003, Government Code.
- 9 (2) "Line of duty" and "personal injury" have the
- 10 meanings assigned by Section 615.021(e), Government Code.
- 11 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the clerk of a court may
- 12 not charge, or collect from, the estate of an eligible proposed ward
- 13 or eligible ward any of the following fees if the court finds the
- 14 proposed ward or ward became incapacitated as a result of a personal
- 15 injury sustained in the line of duty in the individual's position as
- 16 described by Section 615.003, Government Code:
- 17 (1) a fee for the filing of a guardianship proceeding;
- 18 and
- 19 (2) a fee for any service rendered by the court
- 20 regarding the administration of the guardianship.
- 21 (c) The clerk of a county court is not required to refund a
- 22 fee exempt under this section that is paid before September 1, 2017.
- 23 This subsection expires September 1, 2019.
- SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a
- 25 guardianship proceeding that is pending or commenced on or after
- 26 the effective date of this Act.
