A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the offense of operating certain vehicles without a

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 504.943, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (b) A person commits an offense if the person operates on a
- 9 public highway during a registration period a road tractor, a
- 10 motorcycle, \underline{a} trailer, \underline{a} [\underline{or}] semitrailer, or a motor vehicle
- 11 equipped by the manufacturer with not more than one area to display
- 12 <u>a license plate</u> that does not display a license plate that:
- 13 (1) has been assigned by the department for the
- 14 period; and
- 15 (2) complies with department rules regarding the
- 16 placement of license plates.
- 17 (b-1) In this section, "area to display a license plate"
- 18 means a feature of the exterior front or rear of a motor vehicle to
- 19 which a person can fasten a license plate as required by rules
- 20 regarding the placement of license plates adopted by the board
- 21 under Section 504.010(c). The term does not include a feature if a
- 22 person can only fasten a license plate to the feature after drilling
- 23 through the exterior of the vehicle.
- 24 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only

- 1 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 2 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 3 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 4 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 5 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 6 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 7 before that date.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
