4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 531.0216, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
7	(g) The system developed and implemented under this section
8	must allow a physician or a health care facility, including a
9	hospital, to be reimbursed under Medicaid for the following
10	services performed by a respiratory care practitioner acting under
11	the delegation and supervision of a physician and acting within the
12	scope of the respiratory care practitioner's certification or
13	<pre>permit:</pre>
14	(1) telemedicine medical services, telehealth
15	services, and home telemonitoring services provided by a
16	respiratory care practitioner located at a distant site to a
17	patient located at a patient site; and
18	(2) services provided in support of the delivery of
19	telemedicine medical services, telehealth services, or home
20	telemonitoring services by a respiratory care practitioner located
21	at a patient site to a patient located at the patient site.
22	SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act

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a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a

federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,

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- 1 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 2 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 3 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
