## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to allowing the Texas Workforce Commission (Commission) to 2 3 cash a warrant with a restricted or conditional endorsement without 4 settling the amount of money due to the Commission. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 213, Subtitle A, Title 4, Labor Code, is amended by adding Section 213.012 to read as follows: 7 8 Sec. 213.012. RESTRICTED OR CONDITIONAL PAYMENTS PROHIBITED. A restriction or condition placed on a negotiable 9 10 instrument or any other form of payment, physical or electronic, in payment of contributions, penalties, or interest by the maker that 11 12 limits the amount of contributions, penalties, or interest owed to 13 an amount less than that calculated under this subtitle, reflected on the statement of account, or shown by commission records, is void 14 15 unless the restriction or condition is authorized by this code. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2017. 20
