11	department's Internet website information regarding the systematic
12	protocol for pregnancy-related death investigations and the best
13	practices for reporting pregnancy-related deaths to the medical
14	examiner or justice of the peace of each county, as applicable.
15	(b) The information provided under Subsection (a) must
16	<pre>include guidelines for:</pre>
17	(1) determining when a comprehensive toxicology
18	screening should be performed on a person whose death was related to
19	<pre>pregnancy;</pre>
20	(2) determining when a death should be reported to or
21	investigated by a medical examiner or justice of the peace under
22	Chapter 49, Code of Criminal Procedure; and
23	(3) correctly completing the death certificate of a
24	person whose death was related to pregnancy.
