(a) The department shall post on the 10 department's Internet website information regarding the systematic 11 protocol for pregnancy-related death investigations and the best 12 practices for reporting pregnancy-related deaths to the medical 13 examiner or justice of the peace of each county, as applicable. 14 (b) The information provided under Subsection (a) must 15 16 include guidelines for: (1) determining when a comprehensive toxicology 17 screening should be performed on a person whose death was related to 18 19 pregnancy; 20 (2) determining when a death should be investigated by a medical examiner or justice of the peace under Chapter 49, Code of 21 Criminal Procedure; and 22 23 (3) correctly completing the death certificate of a 24 person whose death was related to pregnancy.
