## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to cemeteries.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 711.001, Health and Safety Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 711.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
- 7 (1) "Abandoned cemetery" means a cemetery, regardless
- 8 of whether it appears on a map or in deed records, that is not owned
- 9 or operated by a cemetery organization, does not have another
- 10 person legally responsible for its care, and is not maintained by
- 11 any person.
- 12  $\underline{(2)}$  [ $\underline{(1)}$ ] "Burial park" means a tract of land that is
- 13 used or intended to be used for interment in graves.
- 14 (3)  $\left[\frac{(1-a)}{1-a}\right]$  "Campus" means the area:
- (A) within the boundaries of one or more adjacent
- 16 tracts, parcels, or lots under common ownership;
- 17 (B) on which the principal church building and
- 18 related structures and facilities of an organized religious society
- 19 or sect are located; and
- (C) that may be subject to one or more easements
- 21 for street, utility, or pipeline purposes.
- 22  $\underline{(4)}$  [ $\underline{(2)}$ ] "Cemetery" means a place that is used or
- 23 intended to be used for interment, and includes a graveyard, burial
- 24 park, mausoleum, or any other area containing one or more graves.

- 1 (5)  $\left[\frac{(2-a)}{2}\right]$  "Cemetery element" means a grave,
- 2 memorial, crypt, mausoleum, columbarium, or other item that is
- 3 associated with the cemetery, including a fence, road, curb, wall,
- 4 path, gate, or bench and the lighting and landscaping.
- 5 (6)  $[\frac{(2-b)}{}]$  "Cemetery broker" means a person who sells
- 6 the exclusive right of sepulture for another person. The term does
- 7 not include a person who:
- 8 (A) is an officer, agent, or employee of the
- 9 cemetery organization in which the plot is located and who is exempt
- 10 from registration under Subchapter C-1; or
- 11 (B) originally purchased the exclusive right of
- 12 sepulture for personal use.
- 13 (7) [<del>(3)</del>] "Cemetery organization" means:
- 14 (A) an unincorporated association of plot owners
- 15 not operated for profit that is authorized by its articles of
- 16 association to conduct a business for cemetery purposes; or
- 17 (B) a corporation, as defined by Section
- 18 712.001(b)(3), that is authorized by its certificate of formation
- 19 or its registration to conduct a business for cemetery purposes.
- (8)  $[\frac{4}{1}]$  "Cemetery purpose" means a purpose
- 21 necessary or incidental to establishing, maintaining, managing,
- 22 operating, improving, or conducting a cemetery, interring remains,
- 23 or caring for, preserving, and embellishing cemetery property.
- 24 (9) [<del>(5)</del>] "Columbarium" means a durable, fireproof
- 25 structure, or a room or other space in a durable, fireproof
- 26 structure, containing niches and used or intended to be used to
- 27 contain cremated remains.

- 1  $\underline{(10)}$  [(5-a)] "Cremains receptacle" means a marker,
- 2 boulder, bench, pedestal, pillar, or other aboveground vessel that
- 3 contains niches for cremated remains.
- 4 (11)  $[\frac{(6)}{(6)}]$  "Cremated remains" or "cremains" means the
- 5 bone fragments remaining after the cremation process, which may
- 6 include the residue of any foreign materials that were cremated
- 7 with the human remains.
- 8  $\underline{(12)}$  [ $\overline{(7)}$ ] "Cremation" means the irreversible process
- 9 of reducing human remains to bone fragments through extreme heat
- 10 and evaporation, which may include the processing or the
- 11 pulverization of bone fragments.
- 12 (13) [<del>(8)</del>] "Crematory" means a structure containing a
- 13 furnace used or intended to be used for the cremation of human
- 14 remains.
- 15 (14)  $[\frac{(9)}{}]$  "Crematory and columbarium" means a
- 16 durable, fireproof structure containing both a crematory and
- 17 columbarium.
- 18 (15)  $[\frac{(10)}{}]$  "Crypt" means a chamber in a mausoleum of
- 19 sufficient size to inter human remains.
- 20 (16) [(11)] "Directors" means the governing body of a
- 21 cemetery organization.
- (17)  $[\frac{(12)}{}]$  "Entombment" means interment in a crypt.
- 23 (18) [(13)] "Funeral establishment" means a place of
- 24 business used in the care and preparation for interment or
- 25 transportation of human remains, or any place where one or more
- 26 persons, either as sole owner, in copartnership, or through
- 27 corporate status, are engaged or represent themselves to be engaged

- 1 in the business of embalming or funeral directing.
- 2 (19)  $[\frac{(14)}{(14)}]$  "Grave" means a space of ground that
- 3 contains interred human remains or is in a burial park and that is
- 4 used or intended to be used for interment of human remains in the
- 5 ground.
- 6 (20) [(15)] "Human remains" means the body of a
- 7 decedent.
- 8 (21) [(16)] "Interment" means the permanent
- 9 disposition of remains by entombment, burial, or placement in a
- 10 niche.
- 11 (22) [(17)] "Interment right" means the right to inter
- 12 the remains of one decedent in a plot.
- 13 (23) [(18)] "Inurnment" means the placement of
- 14 cremated remains in an urn.
- 15 (24) [(19)] "Lawn crypt" means a subsurface
- 16 receptacle installed in multiple units for ground burial of human
- 17 remains.
- 18 (25) [<del>(20)</del>] "Mausoleum" means a durable, fireproof
- 19 structure used or intended to be used for entombment.
- 20 (26)  $\left[\frac{(20-a)}{}\right]$  "Memorial" means a headstone,
- 21 tombstone, gravestone, monument, or other marker denoting a grave.
- 22 (27)  $\left[\frac{(21)}{}\right]$  "Niche" means a space in a columbarium or
- 23 cremains receptacle used or intended to be used for the placement of
- 24 cremated remains in an urn or other container.
- 25 (28) [<del>(22)</del>] "Nonperpetual care cemetery" means a
- 26 cemetery that is not a perpetual care cemetery.
- 27 (29) [<del>(23)</del>] "Perpetual care" or "endowment care"

- 1 means the maintenance, repair, and care of all places in the
- 2 cemetery.
- 3 (30)  $\left[\frac{(24)}{}\right]$  "Perpetual care cemetery" or "endowment
- 4 care cemetery" means a cemetery for the benefit of which a perpetual
- 5 care trust fund is established as provided by Chapter 712.
- 6 (31)  $\left[\frac{(25)}{}\right]$  "Plot" means space in a cemetery owned by
- 7 an individual or organization that is used or intended to be used
- 8 for interment, including a grave or adjoining graves, a crypt or
- 9 adjoining crypts, a lawn crypt or adjoining lawn crypts, or a niche
- 10 or adjoining niches.
- 11 (32) [(26)] "Plot owner" means a person:
- 12 (A) in whose name a plot is listed in a cemetery
- 13 organization's office as the owner of the exclusive right of
- 14 sepulture; or
- 15 (B) who holds, from a cemetery organization, a
- 16 certificate of ownership or other instrument of conveyance of the
- 17 exclusive right of sepulture in a particular plot in the
- 18 organization's cemetery.
- 19 (33) [<del>(27)</del>] "Prepaid funeral contract" means a
- 20 written contract providing for prearranged or prepaid funeral
- 21 services or funeral merchandise.
- 22  $\underline{(34)}$  [(28)] "Remains" means either human remains or
- 23 cremated remains.
- 24 (35) "Unidentified grave" means a grave that is not
- 25 marked in a manner that provides the identity of the interment.
- 26 (36) "Unknown cemetery" means an abandoned cemetery
- 27 evidenced by the presence of marked or unmarked graves that does not

- 1 appear on a map or in deed records.
- 2 (37) "Unmarked grave" means the immediate area where
- 3 one or more human interments are found that:
- 4 (A) is not in a recognized and maintained
- 5 cemetery;
- 6 (B) is not owned or operated by a cemetery
- 7 <u>organization;</u>
- 8 <u>(C) is not marked by a tomb,</u> monument,
- 9 gravestone, or other structure or thing placed or designated as a
- 10 memorial of the dead; or
- 11 (D) is located on land designated as
- 12 agricultural, timber, recreational, park, or scenic land under
- 13 Chapter 23, Tax Code.
- 14 (38) "Unverified cemetery" means a location having
- 15 some evidence of interment but in which the presence of one or more
- 16 unmarked graves has not been verified by a person described by
- 17 Section 711.0105(a) or by the Texas Historical Commission.
- 18 SECTION 2. Section 711.004, Health and Safety Code, is
- 19 amended by adding Subsection (f-1) to read as follows:
- 20 (f-1) For unmarked graves contained within an abandoned,
- 21 unknown, or unverified cemetery, a justice of the peace acting as
- 22 coroner or medical examiner under Chapter 49, Code of Criminal
- 23 Procedure, or a person described by Section 711.0105(a) may
- 24 investigate or remove remains without written order of the state
- 25 registrar or the state registrar's designee.
- SECTION 3. The heading to Section 711.010, Health and
- 27 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:

- 1 Sec. 711.010. <u>ABANDONED</u>, UNKNOWN, OR <u>UNVERIFIED</u>
- 2 [ABANDONED] CEMETERY.
- 3 SECTION 4. Section 711.010, Health and Safety Code, is
- 4 amended by amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsection
- 5 (d) to read as follows:
- 6 (a) The owner of property on which an unknown cemetery is
- 7 discovered or on which an abandoned cemetery is located may not
- 8 construct improvements on the property in a manner that would
- 9 [further] disturb the cemetery until the human remains interred in
- 10 the cemetery are removed under a written order issued by the state
- 11 registrar or the state registrar's designee under Section
- 12 711.004(f) and under an order of a district court as provided by
- 13 this section, except as provided by Section 711.004(f-1).
- 14 (b) On petition of the owner of the property, a district
- 15 court of the county in which an unknown cemetery is discovered or an
- 16 abandoned cemetery is located may order the removal of any
- 17 dedication for cemetery purposes that affects the property if the
- 18 court finds that the removal of the dedication is in the public
- 19 interest. If a court orders the removal of a dedication of a
- 20 cemetery and all human remains <u>in that cemetery</u> [<del>on the property</del>]
- 21 have not previously been removed, the court shall order the removal
- 22 of the human remains from the cemetery to a perpetual care cemetery
- 23 or a municipal or county cemetery.
- 24 (d) The Texas Historical Commission, with consent of the
- 25 landowner, may investigate a suspected but unverified cemetery or
- 26 may delegate the investigation to a qualified person described by
- 27 Section 711.0105(a).

- C.S.S.B. No. 1630
- 1 SECTION 5. The heading to Section 711.011, Health and
- 2 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 711.011. FILING RECORD OF UNKNOWN OR ABANDONED
- 4 CEMETERY.
- 5 SECTION 6. Section 711.011(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A person who discovers an unknown or abandoned cemetery
- 8 shall file notice of the discovery of the cemetery with the county
- 9 clerk of the county in which the cemetery is located and
- 10 concurrently mail notice to the landowner on record in the county
- 11 appraisal district not later than the 10th day after the date of the
- 12 discovery. The notice must contain a legal description of the land
- 13 on which the unknown or abandoned cemetery was found and describe
- 14 the approximate location of the cemetery and the evidence of the
- 15 cemetery that was discovered.
- SECTION 7. Subchapter A, Chapter 711, Health and Safety
- 17 Code, is amended by adding Section 711.0111 to read as follows:
- Sec. 711.0111. NOTICE OF UNVERIFIED CEMETERY. (a) A person
- 19 who discovers an unverified cemetery shall file notice and evidence
- 20 of the discovery with the Texas Historical Commission on a form
- 21 provided by the Texas Historical Commission, and shall concurrently
- 22 provide a copy of the notice to the landowner on record in the
- 23 county appraisal district on whose land the unverified cemetery is
- 24 <u>located.</u>
- 25 (b) The landowner described by Subsection (a) may send a
- 26 response or comments to the Texas Historical Commission concerning
- 27 the notice not later than the 30th day after the date the notice is

- 1 <u>filed.</u>
- 2 (c) The Texas Historical Commission shall evaluate the
- 3 <u>notice of the unverified cemetery, the evidence submitted with the</u>
- 4 notice, and the response of the landowner, if any, and shall
- 5 determine whether there is sufficient evidence of the existence of
- 6 <u>a cemetery.</u>
- 7 <u>(d) If the Texas Historical Commission determines</u>
- 8 sufficient evidence supports the existence of a cemetery, the Texas
- 9 Historical Commission shall inform the landowner and may file
- 10 notice of the existence of the cemetery under Section 711.011.
- 11 (e) If the Texas Historical Commission determines
- 12 sufficient evidence supports a determination that a cemetery does
- 13 <u>not exist, the Texas Historical Commission shall notify the</u>
- 14 landowner on record in the appraisal district of its determination,
- 15 amend the notice to include the commission's determination, and
- 16 ensure any notice filed with a county clerk under Section 711.011 is
- 17 corrected.
- 18 SECTION 8. Section 711.041, Health and Safety Code, is
- 19 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 20 (d) This section does not apply to an unverified cemetery.
- SECTION 9. Section 712.0441(f-1), Health and Safety Code,
- 22 is amended to read as follows:
- (f-1) The commissioner may issue an order requiring
- 24 restitution by a person if, after notice and opportunity for a
- 25 hearing held in accordance with the procedures for a contested case
- 26 hearing under Chapter 2001, Government Code, the commissioner finds
- 27 that the corporation has not ordered memorials, as defined by

- 1 Section  $\frac{711.001}{(20-a)}$  [ $\frac{711.001(20-a)}{(20-a)}$ ], in compliance with the deadlines
- 2 established by rules adopted under this chapter.
- 3 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
