5	SECTION 1. Section 508.187, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
7	(b-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (b)(1)(B), a requirement
8	that a releasee not go in, on, or within a distance specified by a
9	parole panel of certain premises does not apply to a releasee while
10	the releasee is traveling directly en route on a public or private
11	roadway between locations at which the releasee has legitimate
12	business.
13	SECTION 2. Section 508.225, Government Code, is amended by
14	adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
15	(a-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (a)(2), a requirement that
16	an inmate not go in, on, or within a distance specified by a parole
17	panel of certain premises does not apply to an inmate while the
18	inmate is traveling directly en route on a public or private roadway
19	between locations at which the inmate has legitimate business.
20	SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
21	person on parole or mandatory supervision on or after the effective
22	date of this Act, regardless of whether the person was released on
23	parole or to mandatory supervision before, on, or after that date.
24	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
